

A report on “Biodiversity conservation and its role in mitigating climate change” (23.12.2021)

The programme was divided into two parts. The outdoor identification programmes in Ornithology, Entomology and Botany and these were held at Golden Jubilee Eco park Tepania. The identification programme in ornithology began at 6:40 am instead of prescheduled 6 am owing to late arrival of some students (some however were very punctual and had actually arrived before time) as well as staff of the park and continued till 9:30am. The findings of the day were reported in ebird. The identification programmes in Entomology and Botany began at 10 am with a delay of 30 minutes and continued till 11:30 am. The indoor programme began at 12:30 pm at the smart classroom in life science building with the keynote address by Dr Dipak Sinha replacing Mr. Siddhartha Debbarma who couldn't join because of some unforeseeable reasons. This was followed by lectures by Dr. Kaushik Majumdar who spoke on traditional knowledge and Dr. Joydeb Majumder addressing the characteristics for insect identification. The last part of the programme was poster presentation by students.





The significance of the programme is evident from the title itself. It was however a very satisfactory outcome that many students started to think seriously about the issues discussed. Some were even motivated to take part in future events and actually did participate in an event organized by the forest Department on 26.12.2021 Golden Jubilee Eco Park Tepania.
