ADMISSION NOTICE FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24

As per Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Tripura Notification No. F.2(390)-DHE/UDCA/2020 dated 08.06.2023, admission notice is hereby issued for HS (+2) passed students from recognized Boards/Councils for admission into B.A/B.Sc./B.Com first semester Programmes for Academic Year 2023-24 in accordance with the NEP 2020 Under Graduate Programme guidelines provided by the DHE, Tripura and Tripura University (A Central University). The schedule of admission process, course-wise eligibility, selection procedure, admission restrictions, intake capacity and fee structure are given below.

Interested candidates must submit the duly filled application form along with supporting documents on or before the dates declared by the Directorate of Higher Education.

Course-Wise Eligibility:

A student who has passed Higher Secondary/H.S.(+2 stage)/Senior Secondary examination or equivalent from any recognized board/council shall be eligible for admission to the 1st Semester of Under Graduate (B.A./B.Sc/B.Com) programme subject to availability of seats. The students shall be taken into consideration for admission if he/she applied within five years from year of passing. The year of admission shall not be

taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

- For B.Sc. (Physical Science): A candidate who has passed 10+2 stage with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics shall be eligible for admission.
- For B.Sc. (Biological Science): A candidate who has passed 10+2 stage with Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be eligible for admission.
- For B.Com. Programme: A candidate who has passed 10+2 with Commerce/Science will be eligible to take admission in B.Com.
- For B.A. Programme: A candidate who has passed 10+2 in any stream shall be eligible to take admission.

Selection Procedure:

- Major, Minor & Interdisciplinary subjects should not be same.
- A student can apply for maximum three subjects as Major. Major subject will be allotted strictly on the basis of merit.
- Students will mention four subjects as Minor in order of preference (mentioning four subjects as Minor in the application form is mandatory for students applying for Arts Programme).
- Students will mention four subjects for Interdisciplinary Course in order of preference (mentioning four subjects in the application form is mandatory for students applying for Arts Programme).
- The merit list will be prepared on the basis of sum of marks of the Best Five subjects of H.S.(+2) Exam and the subject opted for Major.
- If there is a tie in the sum, preference will be given to the marks obtained in the subject opted as Major (for breaking the tie).
- If marks of the subject opted as Major is also equal, then the date of birth of the candidate will be considered. Senior will be given chance.
- The merit list will be published for Major subject only.
- Minor and interdisciplinary subject will be distributed among the students subject to availability of seat.
- Reservation policy of Government of Tripura will be followed.

Admission Restrictions:

• A candidate cannot take admission simultaneously in two different colleges. In case of admission in a second college, the admission in first college must be surrendered.
